Applicable underlying diseases

\sim Persons visiting or admitted to hospitals for the following diseases or conditions \sim

- Chronic Respiratory Disease
- Chronic Heart Disease (Includes high blood pressure)
- · Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Liver Disease (Liver cirrhosis, etc.)
- · Diabetes mellitus being treated with insulin or medication or diabetes complicated with other disease
- Blood Disease (Except for iron deficiency anemia)
- Diseases that weakens the immune system (Includes malignant tumors undergoing treatment and palliative care)
- · Receiving treatment that reduces immune function, such as steroids
- Neurological and neuromuscular diseases associated with abnormalities in the immune system
- Decreased body functions due to neurological or neuromuscular diseases (respiratory disorder)
- Chromosomal abnormality
- Severe physical and mental illness (severe physical disability combined with severe mental retardation)
- Sleep apnea syndrome
- Serious mental illness (hospitalized for treatment of mental illness, holding the Mental Disability Welfare Booklet, or falling under the category of "severe and continuous" in the Medical Care for Services and Support for persons with disabilities (outpatient mental health care)) or intellectual disability (holding Rehabilitation Certificate)

Guideline for BMI30: Height 170cm, Weight about 87kg
